

RULES AND CONDITIONS

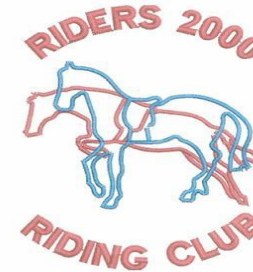
- This Combined Training Competition will be run under Riding Club Rules. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that they are complying with the rules of this competition. The BRC Rulebook can be found at <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook>
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary.
- Competitors failing to obey the instructions given by the Stewards, Judges or other officials will be disqualified.
- The judge's decision is final. Any objections or protests must be handed to the Secretary in writing with a deposit of £20 within 15 minutes of the results being published. The deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.
- Part entry fees refunded only on production of a vets/doctors certificate.
- No farrier on call – please ensure your horse/pony is well shod.
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead and under control at all times.
- Young children must be supervised at all times.
- Horses and ponies must not be left unattended in the lorry park unless secured correctly inside a trailer/horsebox.
- Age as at 1st January 2017.
- Any horse/pony jumping hors concur must remain so for the rest of the event
- Please respect the hospitality of the Landowners and take your litter home. Do not clean out your horsebox/trailer in the field.
- In the event of a cancellation, refunds will be issued within six weeks of the date of the competition. 10% of each entry will be kept to cover the administration costs.
- Please note the rules for correct Tack and Riders attire, this will be checked. Hard hats to current standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
- Horses or ponies must be 4 years of age and over, no horse/pony to be entered more than once in any one class.

Legal Liability: No responsibility can be taken for the theft, loss damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

Health, Safety & Welfare: The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards.

Any persons attending this event or being on any ground associated with this event does so entirely at their own risk.

Classes

Class 1- JUNIOR RC QUALIFIER

Class 2- SENIOR RC QUALIFIER

Classes 1 & 2 are open to teams of four and individuals.

Two riders in each team will compete in:

- Dressage Test BRC HT90 Q (2013); and
- Show Jumping at 75cm;

and two riders will compete in:

- Dressage Test BRC HT100 Q (2013); and
- Show Jumping at 85cm

Individuals may choose the level at which they would like to compete.

Class 3 – Individuals – NON QUALIFIER

- Dressage Test BRC HT90 Q (2013)
- Show Jumping at 75cm

Class 4 – Individuals – NON QUALIFIER

- Dressage Test BRC HT100 Q (2013)
- Show Jumping at 85cm

Entry Fees (including First Aid Cover):

- Individual £25
- Teams £100

Please Note: As this is an Area Qualifying Competition, these entries will take priority over Non-Qualifying entries.

Juniors must be under 18 on 1 January 2017.
